


## 2015 “CHARM ACRES” SONOMA COAST CHARDONNAY

Golden straw, brilliant clarity. Fresh and balanced, this Sonoma County chardonnay offers aromas of fresh stone fruits - white peach, crème brulee, and sea salt – with floral notes of honeysuckle and jasmine. A fresh burst of acidity, followed with touches of toasty oak on the mid-palate and finishes clean with more tart acidity. Well balanced with both minerality and a touch of new oak. Flavors of orange and lemon peel, green apples, baked peaches, brine, graham crackers and vanilla bean.

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:** 100% Chardonnay Sonoma County California

**COOPERAGE:** 12 months in barrel | ML fermentation inhibited | 20% new French oak.

**TECHNICAL DATA:** 14% alcohol by volume | bottled November 2016 | 1225 cases




## 2015 “ALPHABETS” WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR

This Oregon styled Pinot Noir leads off on the nose with a fresh scent of boysenberries and strawberries that swirl together with a hint of white pepper, bay leaves, pine sap, and nettles. The palate delivers a flavor of tart cherries mixed with cranberries that lay on a bed of mushrooms, black pepper, and oyster sauce. This intricate flavor finishes with dusty tannin and bright acid. The wine is red violet in color.

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:** 100% Pinot Noir Willamette Valley AVA in Oregon

**COOPERAGE:** 10 months in barrel | 30% new French oak.

**TECHNICAL DATA:** 13.0% alcohol by volume | bottled May 2016 | 2510 cases




## 2015 “HUNTINGTON” SANTA BARBARA COUNTY PINOT NOIR

Candied nose of sweet cherries, dark chocolate, cinnamon, ripe strawberries, maple syrup, boysenberries, toasted oak, dried thyme. Palate offers up bright red fruits, cherries and raspberries up front with earthy tones of wild mushrooms and black truffles. The mid palate swells with rich acid and flavors of baking spices (clove, mace, cardamom). Long, elegant finish with black licorice, more red fruit and hints of black tea. Ruby Red, Garnet in color, bright clarity – medium bodied.

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:** 100% Pinot Noir Santa Barbara County, CA.

**COOPERAGE:** 10 months in barrel | 25% new French oak.

**TECHNICAL DATA:** 14.8% alcohol by volume | bottled August 2016 | 9277 cases



## 2015 “RIVIERA” SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

Garnet, medium bodied, classic Sonoma County Pinot Noir with aromatics of fresh light red fruits (cherries and strawberries) leaping out of the glass, backed up with baking spices and hints of fresh-picked mushrooms and black tea. Flavors of sweet raspberries and cherries combine with anise, sweet oak and white pepper. A pleasant wine to drink from start to finish – great mouth feel balanced with acidity and soft tannins which provide for a long, silky finish.

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:** 100% Pinot Noir Sonoma Coast California

**COOPERAGE:** 12 months in barrel | 25% new French oak.

**TECHNICAL DATA:** 14.5% alcohol by volume | bottled November 2016 | 3200 cases



## 2012 “SUMMIT” STA. RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR

A serious wine with aromas of black currant, dark chocolate, exotic spices and black berries. Chewy tannins form its great structure carrying loads of black fruits, anise, raspberry and wisps of anise.

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:** 100% Pinot Noir from Sta. Rita Hills in California

**COOPERAGE:** 10 months in barrel; 30% new French oak

**TECHNICAL DATA:** 14.6% alcohol by volume; bottled July 2013 | 2434 cases
