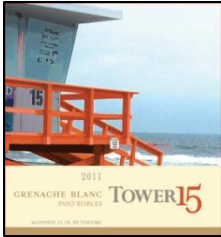


2013 Sauvignon Blanc

Aromatics of honeydew, grapefruit, macadamia nut and sea salt. Fresh with nice weight, depth, and rounded texture. Dried apricot and lime zest lead to mineral intensity and persistence.

100% Sauvignon Blanc from Paso Robles, CA

Cooperage: 3 months in barrel; 50% neutral oak; 50% stainless steel 13.5% alcohol by volume, bottled Jan. 2014; 1212 cases produced.

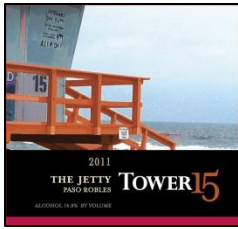


2012 Grenache Blanc

Fresh, vibrant honeydew and honeycomb intertwine with almond, mineral and notes of lime. Beautiful weight and viscosity carry white peach, lime zest and a lingering bread dough finish.

100% Grenache Blanc from Paso Robles, CA

Cooperage: 7 months in barrel; 100% neutral French oak 14.5% alcohol by volume; bottled April 2013; 131 cases produced.

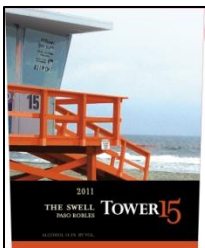


2011 The Jetty

Complex, pure, and initially bright. Ripe raspberry and fresh blackberry give way to undertones of red currant and wild strawberries. Deep, brooding with lingering fig.

41% Syrah, 28% Grenache, 17% Mourvedre, 14% Petite Sirah Paso Robles, CA

Cooperage: 16 months in barrel; 50% new French oak 14.8% alcohol by volume, bottled April 2013; 654 cases produced.

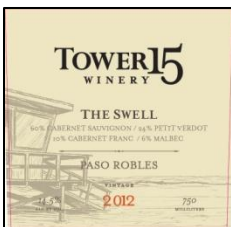


2011 The Swell

A concentrated fruit-laden mouthful. Aromatics of wild raspberries, black cherry, dark chocolate, red licorice and cedar shavings. Lush palate of blueberry, plum, fig and fresh ground pepper.

36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31% Merlot, 12% Malbec, 11% Petit Verdot, 10% Cabernet Franc

Cooperage: 17 months in barrel; 35% new American oak 14.5% alcohol by volume; bottled May 2013; 2076 cases produced

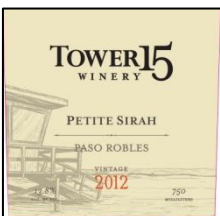


2012 The Swell

Dark, ruby red in color, this wine is brimming with dark chocolate, ripe plums and black cherries with hints of fresh rosemary, and sweet oak on the nose. On the palate, big rich tannins upfront provide a lush mouthfeel. Flavors of blackberry, cranberries and hints of leather abound throughout the long finish.

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Petit Verdot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 6% Malbec from Paso Robles, CA

Cooperage: Aged in barrel for 24 months, in combination of French and American oak. 14.5 % alcohol by volume; bottled May 2014; 1,115 cases produced



2012 Petite Sirah

This wine is a brilliant purple color with silky tannins from start to finish. Hints of blueberry pie, leather, white pepper and red peppercorn on the nose. On the palate this Petite Sirah is big with fresh blackberries, plums and currants up front with a gamey spice on the finish.

100% Petite Sirah from Paso Robles, CA

Cooperage: 16 months in barrel, 30% new French oak 13.8% alcohol by volume; bottled May 2014; 504 cases produced
