


2016 CHARM ACRES CHARDONNAY

Charm Acres Chardonnay is crafted from premium Chardonnay grapes sourced from top vineyards in the Sonoma Coast appellation in Sonoma County. This wine goes through very little malo-lactic (ML) fermentation, remaining bright and lively on the palate. It was barrel-fermented and aged, using 25% new French oak, which adds a hint of richness to this incredibly balanced Chardonnay.

100% Chardonnay from Sonoma Coast, CA.

Cooperage: 10 months in barrel, ML fermentation inhibited; 25% new French oak. 13.5% alcohol by volume; bottled April 2017, 3,909 cases produced.




2016 ALPHABETS PINOT NOIR

"Alphabets" is crafted from 100% Pinot Noir grapes sourced from the notable Ardiri Vineyard in the Chehalem Mountains AVA of the Willamette Valley. This wine is carefully blended to express the unique flavors associated with the Willamette Valley appellation. "Alphabets" is fermented in small lots and barrelaged for 8 months in 30% new French oak. Bottled May 2017.

100% Pinot Noir from Willamette Valley, OR.

Cooperage: 8 months in barrel; 30% new French oak.

12.5% alcohol by volume; bottled May 2017, 2,052 cases produced.




2016 RIVIERA PINOT NOIR

"Riviera" is crafted from Pinot Noir grapes sourced from two vineyards in the Sonoma Coast AVA: Pali's vineyard in the south-eastern corner of the AVA, and a small, family-owned vineyard in the Russian River Valley AVA (a sub-AVA within Sonoma Coast). This wine is fermented in small lots, punched-down up to three times daily during fermentation, then barrel-aged in 30% new French oak for eight months. Bottled in Summer 2017.

100% Pinot Noir from Sonoma Coast, CA.

Cooperage: 8 months in barrel; 30% new French oak

14.5% alcohol by volume; bottled Summer 2017, 7,222 cases produced.




2016 BLUFFS PINOT NOIR

"Bluffs" is crafted from premium Pinot Noir grapes sourced from several notable vineyards in the Russian River Valley AVA and carefully blended to express the unique flavors associated with this appellation. Pali's "Bluffs" is fermented in small lots, barrel-aged for 8 months and bottled in Spring 2017.

100% Pinot Noir from Sonoma Coast, CA.

Cooperage: 8 months in barrel; 40% new French oak.

14% alcohol by volume; bottled Spring 2017, 1,902 cases produced.



2015 Huntington Pinot Noir

"Huntington" is crafted from premium Pinot Noir grapes sourced from notable vineyards located in the following regions of the Santa Barbara County AVA: Sta. Rita Hills, Santa Maria Valley, Santa Ynez Valley and Los Alamos. This wine is carefully blended to maintain consistency from year to year and express the unique flavors and nuances associated with Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir. 100% Pinot Noir from Santa Barbara County, CA.

Cooperage: 10 months in barrel; 20% new French oak.

14.5% alcohol by volume; bottled August 2016, 9,277 cases produced.
