





The 2013 Bluffs Pinot Noir is true to its Russian River appellation, with its dark ruby color, aromatic nose and balanced, pretty composition. An explosion of black cherry, boysenberry and blueberries meet the nose, followed by floral notes. On the palate, there are dark berries, currant, and pink peppercorn. The finish is long, with lingering earthy notes.

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir from Russian River Valley AVA in California

Cooperage: 10 months in barrel; 30% new French oak.

Technical Data: 14.5% alcohol by volume; bottled June 2014, 2,460 cases produced.
