Pali, 2018 Chardonnay ‘Charm Acres,’ Sonoma Coast, CA 750 ML

In 2007, we set out to create our own stylistically crisp and fresh Chardonnay, deeply inspired by the lean white wines grown in Chablis, France. Our ‘Charm Acres’ is crafted from Chardonnay grapes grown on premium vineyards on the Sonoma Coast in Sonoma County. This wine is expertly blend-ed to capture the spirit of the region and express the unique flavors associated with Sonoma Coast Chardonnay, showcasing an elegant balance of richness. The Sonoma Coast sub-appellation, known for its cool climate along the Pacific Ocean, produces Chardonnays with a rich, supple mouth-feel. The grapes are fermented in small lots and then aged in 100% neutral French oak barrels for 240 days. Malolactic fermentation is inhibited, resulting in a crisp style of Chardonnay. 1,210 cases produced

Pali, 2021 Rose of Pinot Noir ‘P.C.H.,’ Central Coast, CA 750 ML

In 2018 we introduced ‘P.C.H.’ to showcase select barrels of rosé made from Pinot Noir grown on some of our favorite vineyards on the Central Coast. Today, our ‘P.C.H.’ is crafted from Pinot Noir grapes grown on Pali Vineyard, our 50-acre vineyard that sits on a gentle southeast facing slope comprising mostly sandy soil, and other premium vineyards on the Central Coast. When made into a rosé, Pinot Noir maintains its light, fruity characteristics and stunning acidity, resulting in a delicious and elegant pink wine. This rosé is made entirely from whole-cluster pressed Pinot Noir. The grapes were picked and gently pressed into a stainless steel tank, and after two days of settling, the juice was racked off its lees into another tank where it began its fermentation. Mid-fermentation, the wine was barreled into 100% neutral French oak barrels that were previously used for red wine aging. We stirred the barrels every day, maintaining fermentation temperature below 68°F, until the wine was bone-dry. P.C.H. was bar-rel-aged in 100% neutral oak for 90 days before bottled. 500 cases produced

Pali, 2018 Pinot Noir ‘Bluffs,’ Russian River Valley, CA 750 ML

While the Central Coast is our home, our curiosity occasionally leads us to distant lands. Our ‘Bluffs’ is crafted from Pinot Noir grapes grown on premium vineyards in the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County. The Russian River Valley AVA is highly acclaimed and internationally known for its wines that display opulent fruitiness, and its cool climate and coastal fog work together to produce distinct flavor profiles with a balanced layer of acidity. This wine is expertly blended to capture the spirit of the region and express the unique flavors associated with Russian River Valley Pinot Noir. The grapes are fermented in small lots and then barrel-aged in 80% neutral French oak and 20% new French oak for 240 days. 385 cases produced.

Pali, 2019 Pinot Noir ‘Riviera,’ Sonoma Coast, CA 750 ML

In 2009 we created ‘Riviera,’ one year after the first and successful release of ‘Huntington’ our Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir. Our ‘Riviera’ is crafted from Pinot Noir grapes grown on premium vineyards in Sonoma County. This wine echoes Huntington’s intention—to be an entry-level Pinot Noir, priced accordingly and made with the same standards of excellence and expertise as our more expensive and esoteric vineyard-designated wines. This wine is expertly blended to capture the spirit of the region and express the unique flavors associated with Sonoma County Pinot Noir—showcasing bright red fruit, spice, and earth, with balanced structure. The grapes are fermented in small lots and then aged in 20% new French oak for 240 days. 5,890 cases produced **90 Points, Wine Enthusiast**

Pali, 2019 Pinot Noir ‘Huntington,’ Santa Barbara County, CA 750 ML

After gaining notoriety for our rare and collectible vineyard-designated Pinot Noirs, we embarked on a new challenge to reach a wider audience of wine drinkers. In 2008, we introduced ‘Huntington’ as an entry-level Pinot Noir priced accordingly, and made with the same standards of excellence and expertise as our more expensive and esoteric vineyard-designated wines. Our ‘Huntington’ is crafted from Pinot Noir grapes grown on Pali Vineyard and other premium vineyards in Santa Barbara County. This wine is expertly blended to capture the spirit of the region and express the unique flavors associated with Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir. The grapes from this remarkable region are dark fruited and highly concentrated, producing wines with a powerful structure. The grapes are fermented in small lots and then aged in 80% neutral French oak barrels and 20% new French oak barrels for 450 days. 3,840 cases produced **91 Points, Wine Enthusiast ‘Editor’s Choice’**
